

Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) Center for Global Health (CGH) is seeking an Executive Director. The Executive Director provides leadership and support to MGH clinicians, scientists, educators and others engaged in global health activities. This includes convening thought leaders from throughout the MGH, leading and designing a comprehensive infrastructure and processes to respond to humanitarian relief/international disaster situations, promoting educational opportunities to enhance care for widely varied populations, and maintaining strong alliances with governmental, non-governmental and academic agencies/institutions.

Reporting to the Senior Vice President for Patient Care and Chief Nurse, with guidance from the MGH Center for Global Health Advisory Committee, the Executive Director is responsible for strategy, developing short- and long-term operational goals, the strategic plan, and to further the mission of improving the health of the world's vulnerable and crisis-affected populations through clinical care, education and training, research and innovation. In collaboration with an Executive Committee comprised of representatives from each clinical department and other MGH leadership engaged in global health at MGH, the Executive Director provides leadership and mentoring to those working in the Center and within the MGH.

The applicant will be expected to be active clinically and will supervise Medical Students and Residents in the clinical specialty of the incumbent. The candidate may have an established research program and a demonstrated ability to attract sustained research funding. The successful candidate would be expected to fully integrate with the Center's internationally renowned cross-disciplinary efforts.

Appointment as an Assistant or Associate Professor at the Harvard Medical School will be commensurate with experience, training and achievements in addition to teaching activities. Suitable candidates will have an MD or an MD-PhD, and Board Certification in their clinical specialty.

Although several years of direct clinical and research experience would be advantageous, less experienced candidates with exceptional promise will also be considered.
