Mount Auburn Hospital was founded in 1886 as the first hospital in Cambridge. With 217 licensed beds in all private rooms, the hospital is accredited by The Joint Commission, a member of the American Hospital Association Council on Teaching Hospitals, and the Association of American Medical Colleges. Mount Auburn's mission is to expand access to outstanding care, and advance the science and practice of medicine through education and research.
