The incumbent is a member of a multi-disciplinary team overseeing the diagnostic evaluation of patients admitted to the Pavilion. The incumbent works with assigned patients to provide intensive individual psychotherapy, family therapy and coordination of aftercare planning. The incumbent participates in daily rounds and is expected to provide a brief synthesis of ongoing psychotherapeutic work for each case during rounds. The incumbent participates in case conferences at the time of discharge and completes a comprehensive case report for each patient seen. The incumbent coordinates care with nursing staff as needed and offers training opportunities to nursing staff on relevant topics related to complex treatment resistant depression, anxiety disorders and personality disorders.

Salary and recruitment package in accordance with Hospital policies, and a Harvard Medical School appointment at the academic rank of Lecturer, Instructor or Assistant Professor (full or part time) will be contingent on meeting the requirements for an HMS appointment and candidate qualifications including Massachusetts license, and being board certified/board eligible.

Qualifications: PhD or PsyD in Clinical Psychology and at least 10 years prior experience providing psychodynamic psychotherapy and family therapy to complex patients in tertiary care settings. Licensed as a psychologist in MA.
