

Pediatric Staff Psychologist:

The Cardiac Neurodevelopmental Program at Boston Children's Hospital is seeking a full-time pediatric staff psychologist to join our team. The Cardiac Neurodevelopmental Program serves individuals with congenital heart disease from the prenatal period to young adulthood.

The ideal candidate will have expertise in providing psychological and neuropsychological assessments and evidence-based interventions to children and adolescents with complex medical and neurodevelopmental profiles, including those with autism, intellectual disabilities, anxiety, and/or executive function challenges. We are seeking an experienced clinician with at least 3-5 years post-graduate employment who can assume a leadership role in providing teaching and training to postdoctoral psychology fellows. Experience in cardiac neurodevelopment is preferred, but we will consider candidates who have served children with other high-risk medical conditions in a pediatric hospital as well. An emphasis on multidisciplinary collaboration is key. Opportunities to participate in relevant clinical research with individuals with CHD are available. Appointment at Harvard Medical School at the Instructor, Assistant Professor, or Associate Professor level will be provided commensurate with experience and will require ongoing teaching.

The applicant must have a Massachusetts Health Service Provider license in psychology, be a graduate from an APA or CPA accredited doctoral program with an accredited internship preferred.
