The individual will oversee basic research in the division and have joint appointments within the Department of Medicine and the Department of Pathology (if applicable). The individual will be proposed for an academic appointment as Professor or Associate Professor at Harvard Medical School commensurate with qualifications. This position will include collaborative activities with the Division of Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Endoscopy at Brigham and Women's Hospital and the Mass General Brigham System.

Applicants should be established and highly productive investigators focused on the fundamental biology of gastrointestinal disorders and/or cancers. Board certification in gastroenterology, pathology or oncology is desirable, together with a proven record of accomplishments as an investigator, clinician, and educator. Applicants should have exemplary mentoring, communication and administrative skills. Applicants will oversee research within the Division of Gastroenterology, including oversight of administrative personnel, space, budgeting, recruitment and hiring of staff and new faculty. The individual will also serve as mentor to junior faculty and clinical fellows and be a visionary leader that will continue to grow our research endeavors in the field of gastrointestinal physiology and pathology.
