The Radiology Department at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center, an affiliate of Harvard Medical School (HMS), is seeking enthusiastic applicants for an academic radiologist faculty position in Breast Imaging to join its dynamic team. We are seeking an individual who is looking to continue to drive the research, education, and clinical operations by joining our highly collaborative and collegial group. Candidates will work exclusively in the Breast Imaging division and perform a wide range of breast imaging studies and procedures including screening, diagnostic exams, ultrasound, MRI and needle localization and biopsy.

The well renowned Breast Imaging division has 5 highly dedicated subspecialty-trained faculty members, a Breast Imaging fellowship (2 fellows per year), 1 advanced practitioner, and 1 imaging nurse navigator. The academic Medical Center is a NAPBC approved Comprehensive Breast Center, and ACR designated Center of Excellence, with state of the art digital technology (including tomosynthesis and contrast enhanced mammography), ultrasound, MRIs (including 3.0 T) and multimodal biopsy capability. The successful candidate will be based at the Academic Medical Center.
