This individual will be responsible for the full scope of clinical, research and educational activities of the Echocardiography Laboratory as well as collaborative activities with the other Imaging Laboratories within the Multidisciplinary Cardiovascular Imaging Program at BWH, other departments, Dana Farber Cancer Institute, Mass General Brigham health system, Harvard Medical School, Boston Children's Hospital and other affiliated institutions.

Candidates should have a strong record as a mentor and as a teacher, national recognition for research accomplishments, and possess exceptional leadership, managerial and collaborative skills. Ideally, she/he would be a proven leader with a national reputation in Echocardiography and Cardiovascular Imaging who can lead a complex and successful department to even higher levels of excellence. The successful candidate will develop an academic practice that connects programs at Brigham and Women's Hospital, DFCI, and their outreach networks.

Appointment as Assistant Professor or Associate Professor at the Harvard Medical School will be commensurate with experience, training, and achievements, in addition to teaching activities. An extensive research network and facilities are available at Brigham and Women's Hospital.
