Boston Children's Hospital Department of Urology Full-Time Researcher

Applications are being solicited for a full-time researcher at Boston Children's Hospital, the primary pediatric teaching hospital of Harvard Medical School. Prospective candidates should be eligible for or hold the rank of Assistant Professor at their present institution. The successful candidate will hold a PhD, or MD, PhD degree and will join an interactive research program in the Department of Urology that resides within a very strong research community. Successful candidates will have research interests in disciplines of relevance to genitourinary tract function with a preferred emphasis on regenerative biology and medicine. Areas of interest could include hollow organ physiology, neuroscience, or vascular biology with additional interests in animal models of human disorders. Modern research space and highly competitive start-up funds are available. The investigator will hold both Boston Children's Hospital and Harvard Medical School faculty appointments. The candidate would also be encouraged to form productive interactions with colleagues and other scientists at the institution, particularly those in one or more multidisciplinary programs. The applicant will be expected to maintain a highly competitive research program and attain extramural funding from NIH or other federal agencies. A strong commitment to teaching and mentoring of research fellows and students is required.
