This role specializes in the assessments of children, teens, and young adults who are experiencing neuropsychological and psychological difficulties impacting their academic, social, and/or behavioral functioning. CATS provides comprehensive assessments targeting a range of challenges including ADHD, Dyslexia, Post-Concussive Disorders, Nonverbal Learning Disability, high functioning ASD, depression, anxiety, mood disorders, and psychosis.

Job duties will include administration of neuropsychological, academic, and psychological assessments, supervision in the post-doctoral training program, administrative duties, and attendance and presentation at clinic case conferences. Successful candidate will train and mentor post-doctoral fellows and trainees. **Position is 20-30 hours a week.**

Salary and recruitment package in accordance with Hospital policies, and a Harvard Medical School appointment at the academic rank of Lecturer, Instructor or Assistant Professor (full or part time) will be contingent on meeting the requirements for an HMS appointment and candidate qualifications including Massachusetts licensure.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate should have a doctoral degree from an APA-accredited program in clinical or counseling psychology, a 2-year post-doctoral position in clinical neuropsychology, and an HSP license from the Massachusetts Board of Registration of Psychologists. Knowledge of special education and experience working with students with emotional challenges is required. Strong organizational, communication, interpersonal, and report writing skills are essential. Training and experience with projective assessment preferred.
