The position is for an Attending Infectious Diseases physician who will provide care in the ambulatory clinic and inpatient consultative service. The successful candidate will have clinical training and experience in Infectious Diseases in the acute care hospital and ambulatory care setting. The physician will care for patients with various infectious diseases while focusing on one or more areas of need, including mycobacterial infections, orthopedic infections, and infections in people who use substances.

The MGH Division of Infectious Diseases is committed to building a diverse team trained to deliver equitable, high-quality care. We seek candidates with a clear commitment to diversity and inclusion, multidisciplinary collaborative care, and education and mentorship of trainees. Although several years of experience would be advantageous, less experienced candidates with exceptional clinical and academic potential will also be considered. We strongly encourage applications from candidates who value diversity, inclusion, and health equity.

Candidates must meet the requirements for appointment at the rank of Instructor, Assistant Professor, or Associate Professor of Medicine at the Harvard Medical School with experience, training, and achievements in addition to teaching activities. Suitable candidates will have a Doctor of Medicine degree and be either board-certified or eligible in Infectious Diseases.
