



Gender Multispecialty Service Psychologists

The **Boston Children's Hospital Division of Endocrinology** in collaboration with the **Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences** is seeking up to four (4) highly motivated psychologists to provide clinical care in the Gender Multispecialty Service (GeMS).

These full-time positions are primarily consultative and will entail working within a multi-disciplinary group to provide assessment and guidance for the treatment of gender dysphoria for children, adolescents and young adults. Clinical expertise is required in working with both children and adolescents. Particular expertise in the field of gender diversity/transgender would be a significant asset, but enthusiasm and willingness to learn is most desirable. The position will involve teaching and supervision.

The applicant must possess or be eligible for a Massachusetts health service provider license in psychology prior to assuming the position. Graduates of APA/CPA-approved doctoral programs and internships are required. Academic appointments at Harvard Medical School will likely be at the Instructor or Assistant Professor level commensurate with experience.
