The Massachusetts General Hospital (MGH) Division of Palliative Care & Geriatric Medicine is seeking an Attending Physician trained in Palliative Medicine with exceptional clinical and leadership expertise to become the next Section Head for the Palliative Care Service.

Reporting to the Chief of the Division of Palliative Care & Geriatric Medicine, the Section Head for Palliative Care is directly responsible for the clinical services, quality control, general operations, and overall effectiveness of the Palliative Care Service and is expected to proactively support and participate in the academic, educational, and research missions of the service.

The successful candidate will have clinical training and experience in Palliative Medicine with significant leadership, academic, and professional development experience working in the academic healthcare environment. In addition to their leadership role within the Division, the position will provide care in the ambulatory clinic, emergency department, hospital-based consultative service, and inpatient palliative care unit settings.

The MGH Division of Palliative Care & Geriatric Medicine holds at our core the importance of building a diverse team who are trained to deliver equitable, high-quality care. We are seeking candidates with a clear commitment to diversity and inclusion, mentorship, and professional development.
