



## STAFF PSYCHOLOGIST AT MCLEAN HOSPITAL

McLean Hospital, America's top ranked psychiatric hospital, is inviting applications for a **full-time Staff Psychologist** in a clinical team manager role at the **Behavioral Health Partial Hospital Program** located in **Belmont, MA**.

The McLean Hospital Behavioral Health Partial Hospitalization Program (BHP) provides one- to two-week multidisciplinary intensive treatment to patients stepping down from inpatient level of care, or those seeking to prevent an inpatient hospitalization. The BHP integrates evidence-based behavioral therapy approaches to provide comprehensive, skills-based treatment aimed at stabilizing patients, improving functioning, and preparing for return to outpatient treatment. The BHP's main treatment components include group and individual therapy, case management and aftercare planning, and medication consultation and treatment.

The Staff Psychologist/Clinical Team Manager is responsible for the day-to-day treatment, management, disposition, and aftercare plan for their assigned patients with particular attention to taking responsibility for the prudent use of clinical resources. Successful candidate will provide ongoing assessment of the patient's needs in order to update the patient's plan of care. Other responsibilities will include overseeing a multidisciplinary treatment team comprised of psychiatrists, psychology trainees, and post-baccalaureate fellows and counselors. Candidate will also provide teaching and supervision for psychology interns and postdoctoral fellows.

Salary and recruitment package in accordance with Hospital policies, and a Harvard Medical School appointment at the academic rank of Lecturer, Instructor or Assistant Professor will be contingent on meeting the requirements for an HMS appointment and candidate qualifications including Massachusetts licensure.

### **Qualifications:**

Ph.D. or Psy.D. degree in psychology from an accredited school of psychology. Requires valid Massachusetts licensure appropriate to clinical discipline.
