

Physician Scientist Investigator in Cardiovascular Research

The Division of Cardiovascular Medicine at the Brigham and Women's Hospital (BWH) invites nominations for an outstanding physician-scientist or PhD scientist at the Instructor, Assistant or Associate Professor level. Appointment as an Instructor, Assistant Professor or Associate Professor at Harvard Medical School will be commensurate with experience, training, and scientific achievements.

Primary responsibilities will include independent and collaborative research in cardiovascular disease and related fields, the creation of new collaborations with other investigators in the Cardiovascular Live Sciences (CVLS), Division of Cardiovascular Medicine and the BWH Department of Medicine, and to mentor and supervise trainees and oversee their academic activities. We seek promising candidates who will develop highly successful fundamental or translational research programs relevant to cardiovascular biology and /or disease. The successful candidate will participate in the full range of academic activities, including mentoring of trainees, teaching, seminar series, internal proposal review, and occasional internal symposia. This position comes with dedicated resources, including laboratory space and start-up funding. The research portfolio at the CVLS is supported by NIH grants, foundation awards, and philanthropic gifts.
