

Adolescent Medicine Faculty Physician

The Division of Adolescent/Young Adult Medicine at Boston Children's Hospital is seeking a full-time Adolescent Medicine Faculty physician to join our Division by July 1, 2024. The position is focused on clinical care as well as teaching. The applicant should have expertise in specialized care for adolescent and young adult patients, and strong clinical interest in the delivery of primary care to diverse youth in urban and suburban settings, including those with weight concerns, reproductive health issues, complex care management, and mental health difficulties. Strong interpersonal skills, including the ability to collaborate with multidisciplinary teams, are essential. The applicant should also have experience in teaching of trainees, including medical students, residents, and multidisciplinary fellows (adolescent medicine, social work, psychology, nursing, nutrition). The job responsibilities include clinical care at the main hospital campus at Longwood and the potential for care provision at one of Boston Children's Hospital satellite locations, such as Lexington, Norwood, Waltham, North Dartmouth, or Peabody for 1 session/week; teaching of trainees; ; and opportunities to lead or collaborate on QI and clinical research projects. The applicant must be eligible for a Massachusetts medical license and Board-Eligible or Board-Certified in Adolescent Medicine. The proposed rank for this position will be Instructor or Assistant Professor in Pediatrics, Harvard Medical School. Academic rank at Harvard Medical School is commensurate with accomplishments, scholarship, national recognition, etc.
