

Faculty Position in Rheumatology

The Massachusetts General Hospital Department of Medicine is seeking a board-certified/eligible Rheumatologist to join the Rheumatology Unit in the Division of Rheumatology, Allergy and Immunology for a full-time faculty position to provide clinical rheumatology care.

The position will be focused on outpatient care, with a small component of inpatient rheumatology consult service. In addition to clinical practice, candidates will have opportunities to participate in research, education, and quality improvement initiatives. Candidates will work at the Massachusetts General Hospital main campus and Mass General Waltham and have potential opportunities to work at Mass General community health centers.

Appointment as an Instructor, Assistant or Associate Professor at Harvard Medical School will be commensurate with experience, training and achievements in addition to teaching activities.
