Hospital Medicine at Boston Children's Hospital

The Hospital Medicine program within the Division of General Pediatrics at Boston Children's Hospital (BCH) is seeking clinically and academically oriented BC/BE Pediatricians (including those trained in Medicine-Pediatric programs) and Pediatric Hospitalists to join their thriving program. The Hospital Medicine program encompasses 8 inpatient teams, provides consultation to surgical teams, and covers 2 inpatient med-psych units. The program accounts for approximately 50% of the medical admissions to Boston Children's Hospital and is the major inpatient teaching site for BCH Pediatric Hospital Medicine fellows, Boston Combined Residency Program in Pediatric residents and Harvard Medical School students. Salary and benefits are competitive.

BCH is a teaching hospital of Harvard Medical School and the pediatric staff will obtain an academic appointment at the level of Instructor, Assistant Professor or Associate Professor.
