Reporting to the Division Chief, Thoracic Surgery, the successful candidate will have responsibilities that include clinical care, research and teaching at Mass General Hospital and at our affiliated sites. Appropriately qualified candidates will be considered for leadership roles in several divisional positions.

The ideal candidate will be Board certified in Thoracic Surgery with a minimum of 4 years clinical experience as active clinical faculty. Applicants must possess a strong background of clinical productivity with technical excellence and practice growth. Demonstration of scholarly attributes in research/clinical investigation and teaching are preferred. The ideal candidate should rank at the top of their peer group in academic thoracic surgery, possess expertise in minimally invasive and/or robotic thoracic surgery and program development. The surgeon will have an appointment at the Massachusetts General Hospital and an academic appointment at Harvard Medical School, anticipated at either the Assistant Professor or Associate Professor level.
