The successful applicant will have demonstrated strong clinical capabilities in managing melanoma, including wide local excision, sentinel lymph node biopsy, regional lymphadenectomy, and a thorough knowledge of current immunotherapy and chemotherapy modalities. Experience in regional limb perfusion is preferred. A demonstrated aptitude for multidisciplinary collaboration is critical. The position may include the management of sarcoma, depending on applicant interest and training. Responsibilities will include teaching of medical students and surgery residents, clinical and/or basic research, as well as patient care. Both experienced candidates and new fellowship graduates with exceptional promise will be considered. Appointment as Instructor, Assistant or Associate Professor at Harvard Medical School will be commensurate with experience, training and achievements in addition to teaching activities. Applicants from communities traditionally underrepresented in medicine are welcome.
