

## Faculty Position Department of Medicine Massachusetts General Hospital

The Cardiology Division of Massachusetts General Hospital is seeking a faculty member specializing in Echocardiography with a particular interest in structural heart disease and guidance of transcatheter procedures. The cardiologist will serve as the Director of Interventional Echocardiography.

The successful candidate must be board-certified or board-eligible in Cardiovascular Disease and certified in Echocardiography with Level III training with at least 5 years of experience in treating patients with valvular heart disease. Candidate must have subspecialty training in Advanced Echocardiography and be comfortable with guiding transcatheter procedures including TAVR, mitral and tricuspid interventions, paravalvular leak and ASD closures, WATCHMAN implantations, and percutaneous mechanical aspiration procedures. The candidate will be asked to hold an outpatient practice both in Boston and Revere.

This position is at the level of Instructor, Assistant, or Associate Professor of Medicine. The candidate will be expected to participate in the academic and educational missions of the MGH and the MGH Corrigan Minehan Heart Center.

Additional interest in serving the growing population of patients who have injection drug use and cardiac infections is highly welcomed. Women and minority candidates are urged to apply.
