The TIMI Study Group at Brigham and Women's Hospital (BWH) Division of Cardiovascular Medicine seeks up to three statisticians. These faculty members will lead statistical projects involving data from multiple international cardiovascular clinical outcomes trials. Qualified candidates are required to have extensive biostatistics experience with particular expertise in design and analysis of clinical trial data as well as expertise in survival analysis. The incumbent will also work closely with statistical colleagues to research novel statistical methods as needed, as well as providing continuing education for statisticians and TIMI physician investigators. Thus they should have strong records as mentors and teachers. Appointment as Instructor, Assistant Professor, or Associate Professor at the Harvard Medical School will be commensurate with experience, training, and achievements, including teaching activities. Applicants must have a PhD in biostatistics or related field with a minimum of 2 years of experience.
