

Clinical Psychologist, Behavioral Health Services at Martha Eliot

Boston Children's Hospital, Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences is seeking a clinical psychologist to work within the Behavioral Health Services at **Martha Eliot** in Jamaica Plain, MA.

This 20-hour position will work within a co-located behavioral health team that serves children and young adults from diverse backgrounds in a community-based primary care setting. The psychologist will conduct diagnostic evaluations and deliver individual, family and group therapy to children and families. The position may include opportunities to provide supervision to pre- and postdoctoral trainees.

Candidates with clinical experience in a collaborative care setting and a strong interest in community health care are encouraged to apply. Expertise in working with children and youth of different racial and ethnic backgrounds, underserved populations, and LGBTQ+ mental health needs is a plus. Applicants must possess a Massachusetts Psychologist Provider license prior to assuming the position. Graduation from an APA/CPA-approved doctoral program and internship is required. Appointment at Harvard Medical School will likely be at the Instructor or Assistant Professor level. The position will include teaching.
